<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of our review was to determine if (a) the total funds claimed for reimbursement by the Meigs County Health Department for its Meigs County Dental Defense Program were expended in accordance with the ARC approved grant budgets and did not violate any restrictions imposed by the terms and conditions of the grants; (b) the accounting, reporting and internal control systems provided for disclosure of pertinent financial and operating information; and (c) the objectives of the grant had been met.

BACKGROUND: ARC awarded Grant Number OH-13844-0-I to the Meigs County Health Department for the period January 15, 2001 through June 30, 2002. The purpose of the grant was to assist in establishing a dental clinic to provide affordable, quality health care and preventive/restorative dental care for residents of Meigs County. The Dental Defense Program of the Meigs County Health Department will increase dental services to uninsured/underinsured Meigs County residents. Grant funds will be used to assist in recruiting a dentist who will practice in Meigs County and provide dental services to uninsured/underinsured Meigs County residents using a sliding fee scale with a zero pay component.

The ARC grant funding for OH-13844-0-I was for a total not to exceed \$200,000 of actual, reasonable and eligible project cost. The Grantee shall pay or cause to be paid the non-ARC share of \$50,000 in cash, contributed services or in-kind contributions, as approved by ARC.

SCOPE: We performed a program review of the grant as described in the Purpose, above. Our review was based on the terms of the grant agreement and on the application of certain review

procedures in accordance with the ARC, OIG Review Program. Specifically, we determined if the tasks listed above had been performed, if the accountability over ARC funds was sufficient as required by the applicable Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circulars, and if the Meigs County Health Department had complied with the requirements of the grant agreement. In addition, we discussed the program objectives and performance with the Meigs County Health Department personnel. Our results and recommendations are based on those procedures and were conducted in accordance with applicable Government Auditing Standards.

<u>RESULTS</u>: The following results were based on our review performed at the Meigs County Health Department in Pomeroy, Ohio on March 18 through March 19, 2002.

A. Incurred Costs:

The Meigs County Health Department requested advance payments from ARC totaling \$178,534 of which they had expended \$112,889 as of January 2002. The in-kind contributions as of January 2002 totaled \$34,520. We reviewed the direct and in-kind costs claimed and determined that, in general, the funds had been expended as reported for the grant.

B. Internal Controls:

We did not identify any internal control weaknesses that would have affected the accountability of costs or compliance with the terms of the grant agreement. However, we did note that many controls were in place, such as an elected official, the County Auditor had to approve all payments under the agreement and all program income was being properly offset against expenses under the agreement.

C. Program Results:

Our review of the Meigs County Health Department, Meigs County Dental Defense Program indicated all specific tasks identified in the grant agreement, and summarized above, have been and will be achieved. As of our fieldwork end date, March 19, 2002 the Meigs County Health Department is in the process of requesting an extension through September 30, 2002. In addition, The Meigs County Health Department did submit progress reports in accordance with the grant agreement.
