On May 4, 2020, the USPS OIG was informed that first class mail, including but not limited to, political mail and mail-in ballots, were misdelivered and left near cluster boxes at numerous apartment buildings along (b)(3):39 USC 410 in Paterson, NJ on May 1, 2020. The investigation revealed, through video surveillance, interviews and USPS database was assigned to (b)(3):39 USC 410 on May 1, 2020 and searches that (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) improperly delivered the mail to numerous apartment buildings along his route.

On May 19, 2020, 000 was issued a Notice of Removal (NOR) pursuant to the OIG investigation which charged (b)(6); with Incomplete Disposition of Mail.

No further investigative findings anticipated. This case is closed.

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I. PREDICATION

On May 4, 2020, the United States Postal Service Office of Inspector General (USPS-OIG) was informed that first class mail, including but not limited to, political mail and mail-in ballots, were misdelivered and left near cluster boxes at numerous apartment buildings along (b)(3):39 USC 410 in Paterson, NJ on May 1, 2020.

II. SYNOPSIS

The investigation revealed, through video surveillance, interviews and USPS database searches that (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was assigned to (b)(3):39 USC 410 on May 1, 2020 and improperly delivered the mail to numerous apartment buildings along his route.

On May 4, 2020, USPS OIG received information from postal management at the Paterson Post Office (07510) reporting that first class mail, including but not limited to political mail and mail-in ballots, were left undelivered and unsecured in the vicinity of apartment building cluster boxes on $(\underline{b}(3)39 \text{ USC } 410)$ on May 1, 2020. The mail that was left was subsequently photographed (EXHIBIT 1-3) and delivered properly the following day. The USPS also obtained statements from building staff, customers and postal management (EXHIBIT 4-6). $(\underline{b}(6); (\underline{b}(7)C)$ was assigned this delivery route on May 1, 2020. USPS placed $(\underline{b}(6); (\underline{b}(7)C))$ on Emergency Placement on May 4, 2020 (EXHIBIT 7).

On May 5, 2020, SA (b)(6); and SA (b)(6); interviewed 204B Supervisor, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) (EXHIBIT 8) at Paterson Post Office 07514, supervisor for (b)(3):39 USC 410 (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) on Friday, May 1, 2020.
