2018-0005-INVI-P – Government Ethics: Not Substantiated

The Office of Inspector General (OIG) initiated an investigation based on information received from an Architect of the Capitol (AOC) senior rated (SR) manager. The SR received information alleging that a subordinate AOC manager misused their position and granted overtime to a subordinate as compensation for doing repairs on their personal residence.

The investigation did not substantiate that the AOC manager used their position to coerce personal services, favors, or solicit a subordinate employee to perform work at their personal residence. The investigation found no evidence to corroborate the allegations and further investigation determined that AOC policy was not violated by either the AOC manager or the subordinate. This investigation is closed.
