REPORT SUMMARY

Audit of DIA's Efforts to Adopt and Implement Artificial Intelligence (AI) Capabilities for Intelligence Collection and Analysis, Project No. 2023-1008

In accordance with Section 6721 of the Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023, Congress directed the Inspector General for each Intelligence Community (IC) component to assess their agency's progress in applying artificial intelligence to their intelligence missions. In addition, the Intelligence Authorization Act also outlines specific provisions that each IC component should address and report on their work to incorporate AI into their programs. As such, we will conduct an audit to determine the extent to which DIA's strategic efforts to timely develop, acquire, adopt, and maintain secure and reliable artificial intelligence (AI) capabilities improve intelligence collection and analysis in accordance with applicable policies, standards, and requirements. Additionally, we will assess whether there are any administrative or technical barriers to DIA's accelerated adoption of AI capabilities.

As part of the audit, the Intelligence Authorization Act requires the results to be disaggregated and include input that focuses on the following areas:

- Acquisitions and contracting,
- Personnel and workforce matters,
- Financial management and budgeting; and
- Operations and capabilities.

We plan to perform this audit at DIA Headquarters in the National Capital Region; however, we may identify other locations and offices during the audit. We will interview personnel, including senior officials from the offices of primary responsibility, and other personnel as needed. Additionally, we will request direct access to all records and documentation relevant to the audit objective. We plan to perform this audit in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards
