Summary: Alleged Misuse of Government Credit Card

Report Date: November 3, 2014

OIG investigated anonymous allegations that a Bureau of Land Management (BLM) public affairs specialist used their Government credit card to charge \$18,000 in personal expenses.

We did not substantiate the allegation. We reviewed the employee's Government credit card purchases and examined their travel vouchers and did not identify any purchases or charges that were inappropriate or were not for official purposes.

We forwarded our report to BLM for information only.
