

Summary: Workers' Compensation Investigation of National Park Service Employee

Report Date: September 1, 2015

OIG investigated a National Park Service (NPS) employee after receiving a hotline complaint alleging that the employee may have inappropriately collected workers' compensation benefits. Specifically, the employee had allegedly worked for a nongovernment employer while receiving workers' compensation benefits from NPS.

Our investigation found that the employee had properly filed the required forms with the U.S. Department of Labor. We found no evidence to indicate that the employee had worked for another employer during the period in which the employee had received workers' compensation benefits.

We provided this report to NPS for information only and did not require a response.
